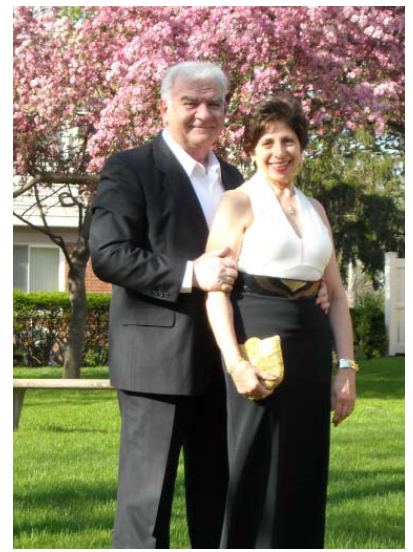


LOU CHALOGIANIS **Farmington Hills, MI** **ELECTRICAL – JUNE** **'59**
